(U) DEFINING BIODEFENSE

DoD adopts the following definitions, based on several definitions in the National Biodefense Strategy:

- **Biological defense (biodefense)**: Actions to counter bioterrorism, reduce risks, and prepare for, respond to, and recover from bioincidents.
- **Biological incident (bioincident)**: Any act of biological warfare or terrorism, a crime involving a biohazard consistent with the scope of the National Biodefense Strategy, or any natural or accidental occurrence in which a biohazard harms the Total Force.
- **Biological threat (biothreat)**: An entity involved with, or a situation involving, a biohazard that can potentially cause a bioincident.
- **Biological hazard (biohazard)**: A biological agent or biologically active substance, regardless of origin (e.g., naturally occurring or biologically engineered), that represents an actual or potential danger to humans, animals, plants, or the environment.

The BPR details specific initiatives and organizational efforts that are necessary to implement these reforms. These initiatives are undertaken in accordance with the NDS and DoD's responsibilities under the NDS and will empower DoD to address current and future biothreats across the spectrum of naturally occurring, accidental, and deliberate bioincidents.

The Defense Department has reached a pivotal point in responding to the quickly evolving biological threat landscape, a senior Pentagon official said today.

Earlier this month, the Pentagon released its inaugural Biodefense Posture Review which lays out key reforms aimed at positioning the department to counter bioterror threats through 2035.

WASHINGTON DC/GENEVA, 2 August 2023—UNAIDS welcomes the launch of the new U.S. Bureau for Global Health Security and Diplomacy which aims to strengthen the global health security architecture to effectively prevent, detect, control, and respond to infectious diseases, including HIV. The Bureau will be led by Ambassador John N. Nkengasong, serving as Ambassador-at-Large, U.S. Global AIDS Coordinator, and Senior Bureau Official for Global Health Security and Diplomacy, reporting directly to the U.S. Secretary of State.

The Department of State's Office of Cooperative Threat Reduction (ISN/CTR) is pleased to announce an open competition for assistance awards through this Request for Proposals (RFP). ISN/CTR invites non-profit and non-governmental organizations and educational institutions to submit proposals for projects that will advance the mission of the Department's Biosecurity Engagement Program (BEP). ISN/CTR has approximately \$40,000,000 available in the current fiscal year to award multiple grants and cooperative agreements in this field. ISN/CTR prefers projects that cost less than \$500,000, though awards may involve multiple projects that cumulatively exceed \$500,000.

IL BACKGROUND AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Office of Cooperative Threat Reduction (CTR), part of the Department's Bureau of International Security and Nonproliferation (ISN), sponsors foreign assistance activities funded by the Nonproliferation, Anti-terrorism, Demining and Related Programs (NADDP) account, and focuses on mitigating proliferation risk in frontier states and regions where the terrorist threat is on the rise, such as South Asia, the Middle East, and North Africa.

ISN/CTR administers the Biosecurity Engagement Program (BEP) program as part of the CTR portfolio. BEP's mission involves institutionalizing biosecurity management best practices and securing life science institutions and important pathogens, decreasing the risk that scientists with dual-use expertise will misuse pathogens, and promoting adoption of and compliance with comprehensive international frameworks that advance U.S. biological nonproliferation objectives, including United Nations Security Council Resolution (UNSCR) 1540, the Biological Weapons Convention (BWC), the World Health Organization's International Health Regulations, and the European Committee for Standardization (CEN) International Organization for Standardization (ISO) standards.

BEP generally funds activities in three priority pillars and has a focus on long-term sustainability. The first pillar increases biosecurity and biosafety through technical consultations, risk assessments, and training courses that develop expertise to create sustainable culture of laboratory biohazard management. As a part of BEP's biosafety efforts, the program also sponsors efforts to train foreign law enforcement and safety forces on approaches for detecting, investigating, and disrupting biosecurity risks; second pillar of engagement focuses on infectious disease detection and control and strengthening the capacity for public and veterinary health systems to detect, report, control disease outbreaks. The third pillar of engagement focuses on scientific engagement to enhance global health security and foster safe, secure, and sustainable bioscience capacity through state scientific collaborations designed to help prevent, detect, and respond to biological threats.

Objectives

By the end of the award's period of performance, the recipient will have successfully developed and implemented a project or projects to advance BEP's mission by:

- Promoting biohazard management practices
- Securing life science institutions and pathogens in priority regions
- Decreasing the risk that scientists with dual-use expertise will misuse pathogens through the detection, attribution, anticipation, and investigation of bioterrorism plots
- Partnering with non-scientific interlocutors such as policymakers, law enforcement, military, and diplomatic audiences to promote biohazard management
- Promoting the adoption of and compliance with comprehensive international frameworks that advance U.S. biological nonproliferation objectives

Funding Priorities

While global in scope, ISN/CTR focuses its resources on prioritized countries to maximize its aim of reducing biological risks. During the current fiscal year, BEP's highest priority countries for engagement are Iraq, Turkey, and Yemen. BEP's second highest priority countries are Afghanistan, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Kenya, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Oman, Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, and Uganda. The program will also consider project proposals for other countries in the Middle East and North Africa, South Asia, Ukraine, sub-Saharan Africa, Southeast Asia and Latin America. Of note, legal restrictions prevent ISN/CTR from providing assistance to certain countries, including developed states, state sponsors of terrorism, and gross violators of human rights.

The recipient shall leverage relevant subject matter experts to create, develop, and implement projects that advance the BEP mission.

... That is the greatest threat to the US. If we lose that status as the worlds reserve currency, the Great Depression will look like a cakewalk."

"We have biolabs in Ukraine because we're developing bioweapons"

RFK also unpacked the issue of US biolabs in Ukraine, detailing how Richard Nixon had shut down the US bioweapons program in **Fort Detrick**, Maryland 1973, until the Patriot Act had effectively eliminated the punishment for US officials for violating the Bioweapons Act.

"We have biolabs in Ukraine because we're developing bioweapons", Kennedy told Carlson, "using all kinds of new synthetic biology and CRISPR technology and genetic engineering techniques that were not available to previous generation. You can make frightening stuff."

"When the Patriot Act reopened the bioweapons arms race in 2001, the Pentagon began putting a lot of money into bioweapons, but they were nervous because if you violate the Geneva Convention, it's a hanging offense. And they weren't sure that the provision in the Patriot Act would actually hold up as a loophole."

Therefore the Pentagon outsourced the bioweapons program to HHS and the National Institute for Infectious Diseases run by Anthony Fauci, Kennedy explained, repeating territory already covered in his book, "The Real Anthony Fauci."

"So Anthony Fauci got all the responsibility for bioweapons development and a 68% raise from the Pentagon in order to do that work," Kennedy charged, which is the reason Fauci became the most highly-paid employee of the US government, over even the President, earning \$450.000 a year.

"Every bioweapon needs a vaccine, because in 100% of cases when you deploy a bioweapon, there's blowback. Your side gets it too." This is the reason for gain-of-function research, which was then banned by the Obama administration 2014 and instead outsourced to Dr. Shi Zhengli's Wuhan, Kennedy stated.

"Fauci built labs all of the country, BSL-3 and BSL-4, we don't even know how many there are. In 2014, three bugs escaped from three different labs. They were high-profile breaks and they were very dangerous: Smallpox and other bad microbes. 300 scientists wrote president Obama and said, you've got to shut down Anthony Fauci because he's going to create a microbe that will cause global pandemic. So Obama signed a moratorium that shut down the worst of Anthony Fauci's experiments. Most of them were taking place in Galveston and in North Carolina, by a scientist called Ralph Baric," Kennedy said.

What OIG Found
Despite identifying potential risks associated with research being performed under the EcoHealth awards, we found that NIH did not effectively monitor or take timely action to address EcoHealth's compliance with award requirements. Although NIH and EcoHealth had established monitoring provisions, we found deficiencies in complying with those provisions. Identify potential problems, and take corrective action. Using its discretion, NIH did not order the research to stop for an outside review for enhanced potential pandemic pathogen (EP3) because it determined the research did not involve and was not reasonably anticipated to create, use, or transfer an EP3. However, NIH added a special term and requirement to the award that required the research to be reviewed by the OIG.

ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO FOR THE INSPECTION OF A FACILITY LOCATED AT 850 I STREET REEDLEY, CA 93654

April 21, 2023

Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Sections 120175.5 (b) & 101070 (b), the Health Officer of the County of Fresno orders as follows:

- The order is issued as a result of multiple attempts to communicate with Universal MedTech Inc. ("Universal MedTech") currently leasing space located at 850 I Street, Reedley, CA 93654 to confirm hazardous materials, biological specimens, and operational practices to ensure hazardous waste and medical waste are appropriately being disposed of in compliance with Federal and State requirements.
- Attempts to communicate with business owners in regards to facility located at 850 I Street, Reedley, CA 93654 since December 15, 2022 from City of Reedley and other public agencies to inspect contents and items at the facility have been unsuccessful.
- City of Reedley building officials posted on March 13, 2023 an Unlawful Occupancy Notice in front of the building. Building has limited power source including refrigerators and heaters that are strong odors, biological samples, appearance of containers used to culture viruses, and multiple chemical containers. Items documented by City of Reedley officials.
- Pharmaceutical investigation into the business concerns does not list items as a licensed laboratory under Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) under the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- City of Reedley reports business owners statements that they are conducting laboratory research on mice for COVID.
- City of Reedley has documented humane treatment of mice on site.
- U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and California Department of Public Health, Food and Drug Enforcement (CDPHE) are conducting an investigation.
